Winter Taxes

Winter taxes are due by Friday, February 14, 2025. 1% interest and 3% penalty will be included starting February 15 and on the first of month thereafter. Make checks payable to *Brown Township*. Options for paying taxes are: mail a check, drop off in the drop box at the township hall or by appointment at the township hall. If paying with cash exact payment is required. Mail payments to: Brown Twp. Treasurer, 9180 River Rd, Manistee, MI 49660. (Include a self-addressed, stamped envelope if you wish to receive a receipt). If using bill pay to send a payment, please make sure the address is correct. Office hours will be held December 30, 2024, February 14, 2025, and February 28, 2025 from 9 AM – 5 PM at the township hall. If you have not yet paid your summer taxes, you can still pay them to the township, please call Melissa for an updated amount due. After February 28, property taxes for the 2024 season must be paid at the Manistee County Treasurers office. No drop ins allowed at the treasurer's home. Good-Bye Brown 7!

Brown 7 was a retired gas sweetening plant located on 12 acres on Collins Road in Brown Township. When it was operational, the plant separated hazardous hydrogen sulfide from petroleum product that was piped in from regional wells. The plant has not been used in this capacity for a number of years due to the depletion of the petroleum reserves, but the equipment has remained on site. In its day, Brown 7 was one of the largest facilities of its kind in the state. The Township Board and Planning Commission have considered the site to be blight on the landscape and have been committed to seeing it reclaimed to its natural vegetative state.

Lambda Energy Resources is an oil and gas company which has been buying old wells and sweetening plants in Michigan. They have an interest in using the sites to store carbon due to the unique geology of the Niagaran Reef along which the old wells are sited. Lambda agreed to clean up the Brown 7 site by removing all of the old, unused materials. This included buildings, towers, tanks, and pipes. At this point, all of the work has been done. The few pieces of equipment that remain onsite will be used to receive and transport (via underground pipeline) condensed CO2 which will be stored in the oil-depleted Niagaran Reef.

Lambda is using this reclamation as a test project for its other sites in the state. They were able to photograph the clean-up process to show before, during, and after images. We hope those photos will be made available for us to post on the website.

Trash Reminder

Brown Township provides no cost trash drop-off for township residents. The waste truck is parked at the Brown Township Hall on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays from 9:00 to 11:00 am. This service is strictly meant for **residential household refuse only**.

The garbage truck will be monitored more closely, and certain items will be refused: construction refuse, yard waste, car batteries, paint, tires and larger items that are not household waste. These types of items need to be taken to the county landfill on Camp Road.
